WHAT IS SALIX FUNDING?

The Salix Public Sector Decarbonisation Grant Scheme is a government initiative designed to support public sector bodies in reducing their carbon footprint.

It provides financial assistance for energy-efficiency and heat decarbonisation projects with the aim to accelerate the move towards a greener future by investing in sustainable technologies and practices.

ELIGIBILITY AND APPLICATION

To be eligible for Salix Funding, your organisation must be part of the public sector in the UK. This includes local authorities, schools, NHS trusts, higher education institutions, and more. The application process typically involves an initial assessment of your proposed project's cost-effectiveness and environmental impact.

PROJECT CRITERIA

Cost-Effectiveness: The project should demonstrate a reasonable payback period through energy savings, typically within five years.

Carbon Reduction: Projects should contribute significantly to reducing carbon emissions.

Compliance: All projects must comply with relevant regulations and standards.
